
UNOSUMAI TOMOSU

Tsunami Memorial Hall

A facility that conveys the events and lessons learned from the earthquake and promotes disaster prevention education.

Exhibition Space

This space introduces the things that happened at the Great East Japan Earthquake, lessons learned, and the approaches to learn about disaster prevention education in Kamaishi.



Archive Space

A library space where you can see and read books, documents, donated photographs, etc. about the Great East Japan Earthquake.



Kamaishi Memorial Park

The facility to pay tribute to the victims of the Great East Japan Earthquake, and teaches lessons of the earthquake to future generations.

Great East Japan Earthquake Memorial

Great East Japan Earthquake Tsunami Height Monument

This is the monument which shows flooding tsunami height (11m above sea level) of Unosumai Station area. It was built to convey the remembrance of the disaster.




Kamaishi Citizens' Charter for Disaster Prevention




Nomura Shoten Souvenir Shop Souvenir and Sake ☎ 0193-28-3351
