
うのすまい・トモス UNOSUMAI TOMOSU


Access

This space introduces the things that happened at the Great East Japan Earthquake, lessons learned, and the approaches to learn about disaster prevention education in Kamaishi.


Archive Space

Great East Japan Earthquake Memorial

This monument has nameplates of the people who became victims of the disaster and flower stands to console their spirits.



Great East Japan Earthquake Tsunami Height Monument

This is the monument which shows flooding tsunami height (11m above sea level) of Unosumai Station area. It was built to convey the remembrance of the disaster.

Kamaishi Citizens' Charter for Disaster Prevention

The monument is inscribed with Kamaishi Citizens' Charter for disaster prevention. It is built as a pledge of the consensus of the citizens to save future lives from all kinds of disasters.

Kamaishi Unosumai Disaster Prevention Center Site

The Monument is written that it is the site of the disaster prevention center where many people evacuated and lost their lives in the Great East Japan Earthquake.
